Subawards and/or subcontracts are usually predicated on the prime award. The of the prime award flow down to the subrecipient. If there are unusual property requirements, they will be stated in a special conditions attachment to the subaward / subcontract. These will include title restrictions and reporting requirements.

Policy:

- 1. It is the policy of the Boyce Thompson Institute for Plant Research (BTI) that any equipment purchased or constructed by a subawardee or subcontractor with funds must be approved in the budget
- Each subaward / subcontract entered into by BTI whereby federal or state
 government property may come under the control of a subrecipient must contain
 specific provisions concerning the subcontractor's responsibility for the custody of
 that equipment.
- 3. A copy of the prime award is generally attached to the subaward / subcontract agreement.
- 4. If property is federally owned, the subrecipient is required to comply with federal regulations (per to OMB 2 CFR Part 200.312): Federally-Owned and Exempt Property) to adequately care for and maintain that property and assure that it is used only as authorized by the contract.
- 4. The subcontractor's approved property control system must include procedures necessary for accomplishing this responsibility.
- 5. Equipment reports must be submitted to BTI's Business Office for referral to the sponsoring agency, as required by the prime award and/or at contract closeout.
